Course Title: Logos in the Jewish Tradition & St. Cyril's Commentary of the Old Testament

Level: Certificate

Duration: October 2025 – June 2026

Course Objective

This course explores the theological and historical understanding of the *Logos* (the Word) within the Jewish and early Christian traditions, and the profound scriptural commentaries of **St. Cyril of Alexandria**, one of the greatest fathers of the Church.

Students will examine how the concept of the *Logos* was received within both **Greek and Jewish thought**, and how the Holy Spirit revealed Christ — the Incarnate Word — to all nations. The course then transitions to a focused study on **St. Cyril's interpretation of the Old Testament**, particularly his work "*Worship and Prayer in Spirit and Truth*,".

Through theological reflection and guided discussion, participants will grow in understanding how these interpretations shape **Orthodox theology**, personal spirituality, and daily Christian life.

Learning Outcomes

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to:

- 1. Analyse the origin and meaning of the *Logos* concept in both Jewish and Greek traditions.
- 2. Understand the role of the Holy Spirit in revealing the *Word of God* to both Jews and Gentiles.
- 3. Identify St. Cyril of Alexandria's interpretations and their importance in Orthodox theology.
- 4. Apply St. Cyril's teachings and spiritual, approaches to Scripture study and spiritual growth.

Course Structure (Modules)

Module 1 – The Logos in the Jewish Tradition: Origins and Context

Module 2 – The Role of the Holy Spirit in Revealing the Word to All Nations

Module 3 - St. Cyril of Alexandria: Life, Legacy, and Theological Method

Module 5 - Worship and Prayer in Spirit and Truth: The Mosaic Books

Module 6 - The Living Word and the Believer's Life

Assessment

Two term exams.

Prerequisites

GCSE (or equivalent secondary qualification).

Delivery Method

The course will be delivered **entirely online** through TEACH's **Learning Management System** (LMS)

All lectures will take place via **Zoom**, supplemented with recorded lectures, assigned readings, and discussion forums on the course website.

Certificate
