Course Title: Defend Your Faith

Level: Certificate

Course Objective

This course aims to equip believers with the spiritual and intellectual tools to defend the Christian faith in a world that increasingly questions it. Drawing from Scripture, patristic wisdom, and reason, the course seeks to train students in **Coptic Orthodox Christian apologetics** — presenting the truth of the Gospel through **logic**, **history**, **prophecy**, **and divine revelation**, while maintaining the humility and love of Christ.

As St. Paul writes, "Since, then, we know what it is to fear the Lord, we try to persuade others" (2 Corinthians 5:11). The course highlights that evangelism is not mere emotion, but a call to unite mind and faith, affirming that:

- The Christian faith is not imposed by force, but **presented through evidence**.
- The truth of the Gospel is not dictated, but **shared with honesty and compassion**.
- Our calling is not fear or intimidation, but rational persuasion and heartfelt conviction.

Learning Outcomes

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to:

- 1. Understand the biblical foundation and patristic tradition of Christian apologetics within the Coptic Orthodox Church.
- 2. Articulate the faith clearly and confidently in response to modern misconceptions, atheism, and relativism.
- 3. Explain and defend the divinity of Christ, the authenticity of Scripture, and the authority of the Church using scriptural, historical, and logical reasoning.
- 4. Recognise the role of humility, love, and spiritual discernment in defending the faith.
- 5. Develop the ability to engage in respectful and intelligent dialogue about Christian belief with people of different or no faith backgrounds.

6. Appreciate how apologetics serves as both a **witness of truth** and a **ministry of love**, leading others to Christ through understanding, not coercion.

Course Structure

1. Introduction to Christian Apologetics

O Definition, purpose, and biblical foundation (2 Corinthians 5:11; 1 Peter 3:15).

2. The Coptic Orthodox Understanding of Faith and Reason

• The harmony between divine revelation and human intellect.

3. Historical Foundations of Christian Apologetics

O The Apostolic Fathers and the early defenders of the faith.

4. The Divinity of Christ and the Authority of Scripture

O Scriptural and theological evidences.

5. Answering Modern Challenges

• Addressing atheism, moral relativism, and the problem of suffering.

6. Apologetics and Evangelism

O How to present the truth in love; practical methods of persuasion and testimony.

7. Patristic Wisdom for the Modern World

• Insights from St. Athanasius, St. Cyril of Alexandria, and other Fathers.

8. Integrating Faith, Logic, and Compassion in Dialogue

• Maintaining spiritual integrity and humility in debate.

Assessment

• Two **term exams** to evaluate overall comprehension, theological insight, and ability to apply apologetic reasoning in real-world discussions.

Prerequisites

- Basic knowledge of Christian doctrine and Scripture is recommended.
- GCSE certificate, high school, or equivalent qualification.

Delivery Method

The course will be delivered **entirely online** through TEACH's **Learning Management System** (LMS).

- All lectures will be delivered live via **Zoom**.
- Students will have access to **recorded lectures**, **reading materials**, and an **online discussion forum** for interaction and questions.

Duration

Certificate
