Course Title: Liturgical History- Year 2

Level: Diploma

Duration: October 2025 – June 2026

Course Objective

This course aims to enable students to understand the wealth of books, scripts, manuscripts, and references related to the Coptic liturgies, and to achieve a thorough and detailed evaluation of the development and progress of the liturgies until they reached their current Coptic Orthodox form.

Learning Outcomes

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to:

- Identify the key liturgical manuscripts, books, and reference materials used in the Coptic Orthodox Church.
- Demonstrate understanding of the historical evolution of the Coptic liturgy through different periods.
- Analyse the development stages of the Coptic liturgy and evaluate its growth into its current form.
- Compare historical and contemporary liturgical practices within the Orthodox tradition.
- Conduct structured research using primary liturgical sources and references.
- Use correct Coptic Orthodox terminology in academic discussion and study of the liturgy.

Module 3 – Analytical Evaluation of Liturgical Progression
