Course Title: Our Lord Jesus in the Old Testament – Year 2

Level: Diploma

Duration: October 2025 – June 2026

Course Objective

This course aims to enable students to study and understand the presence and foreshadowing of Our Lord Jesus Christ throughout the Old Testament. Students will explore the various covenants, narratives, and prophecies that reveal His work, guidance, and relationship with humanity, in accordance with Coptic Orthodox teachings.

Learning Outcomes

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to:

- Identify key Old Testament events, figures, and covenants that prefigure Jesus Christ.
- Explain the theological significance of Jesus' presence in Old Testament narratives.
- Analyse the typology of Jesus in relation to Old Testament individuals and events.
- Interpret Old Testament passages with reference to Coptic Orthodox theology.
- Conduct structured research using primary biblical texts and scholarly references.
- Use correct Coptic Orthodox terminology in discussing Christological themes.

Course Structure (Modules)

Module 1 – Jesus in Covenants and Patriarchs

- Jesus and Abraham Covenant (Gen 15:8-21)
- Jesus and Moses Covenant (Lev 1-7)

- Jesus in the life of Jacob's children (Gen 29-30)

• How do I become another man (1 Sam 10)

- With the blessing they covered Moreh (Jdg 7)
- Jesus in the order of Tabernacle (Ex 25-40)
- Holiness in the Old Testament (Lev 11)
- The complete law of the Old Testament (Ps 19)
- The Lord inheritance to His servants (Is 54:11-17)
